General Premise:

General Premise:

1. The 6-month plan firstly differs from the 6-week plan, because all five authors are being read
 - a. The time commitment for participants is about one hour of reading per week, compared to 30 minutes of reading in the first plan
2. This plan is intended to meet once a month to discuss the White Privilege curriculum more in-depth
 - a. Recommended meeting time is three hours
3. This plan also suggests a break after completing the first three months so that participants are not overwhelmed
4. Above is a recommended assignment schedule to use over the six months; each part and chapter corresponds with the White Privilege curriculum
 - a. The activity and discussion questions that are recommended are entirely flexible, and ought to be decided by each congregation individually.
